

IBIZA

Ca l'Amo is a plot of 42,385 m2 located at the north end of the San Mateo plain on the island of Ibiza. It includes an area of pronounced topography with stone walls running through it, representing an iconic landscape of the countryside of Ibiza.

The house has been organised in five clearly differentiated volumes, creating spaces between them for interaction, services, visual connection with the outside and ventilation. The first three volumes house the programme for a large family with intense social activity. The fourth volume is intended for a large area of outdoor shade, while the fifth houses an annex with independent access for guests.

Between the fourth and fifth volume is the pool and the main leisure and interaction area. The length of the five volumes is determined by the depth of the terrace on which the dwelling sits, which helps to integrate the structure into the landscape.

As materials, dry construction systems have been chosen, with an extensive use of wood and breathable, healthy solutions. The structure of the cross-laminated timber (CLT) panels has been left visible inside, with a focus on a single constructive element for the structure, cladding and finishing. It represents constructional authenticity, while at the same time exuding comfort and environmental warmth.
